

CENSUS OF IRELAND, 1911.

FORM B. 1.—HOUSE AND BUILDING RETURN.

County, Parliamentary Division, Poor Law Union, District Electoral Division, Townland, Parliamentary Borough, City, Urban District, Town or Village, Street, Ward, Parish.

NOTE A.—When a Townland or Street is situated in two Parliamentary Divisions, or in more than one District Electoral Division or Parish, or is partly within and partly without a Parliamentary Borough, City, Urban District, Town, or Village, a separate Return should be made for each portion.

Table with columns for HOUSES (Whether Built, State whether Private Dwelling, etc.) and FAMILIES, &c. (No. of distinct Families, Name of the Head of each Family, etc.). Includes handwritten entries for houses 59-64.

NOTE B.—If one Room is occupied by more than one Family, the Names of the Heads of Families so occupying it should be bracketted together in Col. 13, thus:—John Jones, Peter Murray, and the figure 1 entered in Col. 14, opposite the middle of the bracket.
